



## **SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

### ***Scholarship Application Guidelines***

The Kendrick Juliaetta & 7 Ridges Education Foundation will award scholarships for the pursuit of higher education to deserving and qualified high school seniors graduating from Kendrick High School.

#### **Scholarship Eligibility**

- Applicant must be a graduating senior at Kendrick High School during the 2014-2015 school year.
- Applicant must plan on attending an accredited college, university, community college or technical school.

#### **Scholarship Application Process**

- Applications are available from the Senior Counselor/Advisor at Kendrick Senior High School, and online at [kj7educationfoundation.org](http://kj7educationfoundation.org).
- Applications must be completed fully, accurately and neatly.
- Applications may be typed or handwritten. Handwriting must be neat and legible.
- The required student essay must be attached to the application.
- A copy of the student's high school transcript must be included.
- Two letters of recommendation must be included: one from school staff and one from a community member familiar with the student's qualifications for this scholarship.
- Completed applications must be submitted to the applicant's counselor/advisor by April 1, 2015, or mailed to the Kendrick Juliaetta & 7 Ridges Education Foundation, Scholarship Applications, PO Box 503, Juliaetta, ID 83535. Mailed applications must be received by April 1, 2015.
- Applications lacking any of the required documents listed below will not be considered.

#### **Required Documents**

- Completed application, signed and dated
- Student essay
- Official copy of student's high school transcript
- Two letters of recommendation

#### **Notification of Scholarship Winners**

- The applicant's guidance counselor/advisor will notify the applicant in early May of 2015 if a scholarship has been awarded.

#### **Benefits & Conditions of Kendrick Juliaetta & 7 Ridges Education Foundation Scholarship Awards**

- This scholarship will help to pay for tuition and fees at the college, university, community college or technical school of the applicant's choice during the fall of 2015 and the spring of 2016, provided that the student remains in good standing. Any remaining funds may be used to purchase course materials.

### **Benefits & Conditions of Kendrick Juliaetta & 7 Ridges Education Foundation Scholarship Awards - *continued***

- The number of scholarships to be awarded and the amount of the awards remain to be determined; this information will be made available through the Foundation office and on the official website at [kj7educationfoundation.org](http://kj7educationfoundation.org).
- Scholarships will be disbursed in two equal installments in the fall and spring semesters. The funds will be disbursed directly to the college, university, community college or technical school that the student attends.
- Disbursement of scholarship payments for the spring semester will require proof of satisfactory academic progress, which will be defined as earning a GPA of 2.5 or better with a minimum of nine (9) semester hours. An official transcript must be sent to the Kendrick Juliaetta & 7 Ridges Education Foundation following the close of the fall and spring semesters. Scholarship payments for the spring semester will not be disbursed if an official transcript is not received.
- Any unused portion of the scholarship will remain with the Kendrick Juliaetta & 7 Ridges Education Foundation.

### **Application Checklist**

- The application form is filled out completely, and signed and dated by the student.  
Spelling and grammar should be checked, as they are important factors for consideration.
- Student essay is attached.
- Official high school transcript is attached.
- Two reference letters are attached.
